## Bible Verse:

**"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." — Jeremiah 29:11**

Life can feel overwhelming at times. When the storms rage, and the path ahead feels impossibly dark, it's tempting to throw our hands up and declare, "It's over." But here's the truth: It's not over until God says it's over. You are still here because God has a purpose for your life. He has not given up on you, and He never will. When God made you, He was pleased. He saw everything about you—your strengths, your struggles, your gifts, and even your weaknesses—and He said, "This one is good." You are not here by accident. You are enough. You have enough. Everything you need to face this moment has been given to you by the One who created you.

## God Has Equipped You

You might feel like you're lacking something—that you're not strong enough, smart enough, or capable enough to handle what you're going through. But remember, God doesn't call the qualified; He qualifies the called. Moses didn't think he was a good speaker, but God used him to lead a nation. David was just a shepherd boy, but God made him a king. And you? God has already given you everything you need to get through this season. Trust Him.

## Keep Moving Forward

With each step you take, keep moving forward. Even if the steps are small, even if they feel shaky, they are still steps. God promises to be a lamp to your feet and a light to your path (Psalm 119:105). He won't show you the entire journey at once, but He will guide you step by step. Trust in His timing. Trust in His plan. Whatever you do, don't stop. Keep believing, keep praying, and keep trusting.

## You Will Get Through This

What you're facing right now may feel impossible, but it's not too big for God. He is your strength when you are weak (2 Corinthians 12:9), your peace in the storm (John 16:33), and your hope when all feels lost. You will get through this—not because of your own strength, but because God is with you. He will never leave you nor forsake you (Deuteronomy 31:6). Hold on to that truth.

## A Prayer for Today:

Lord, thank You for reminding me that my story isn't over. When I feel like giving up, help me to hear Your voice louder than my doubts. Remind me that I am enough because You made me. Remind me that I have enough because You are my provider. Give me strength to take the next step, even when the way forward feels unclear. I trust that You are with me and that You have a plan for my life. Thank You for loving me and for never giving up on me. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Final Encouragement

No matter what you're going through, remember this: You are enough. God created you with intention and purpose, and He is not finished with you yet. The same God who made the mountains and the stars made you, and He is pleased with His creation. So don't dare say it's over until God says it's over. Keep moving forward, trusting that God has already equipped you to overcome. You will get through this.
