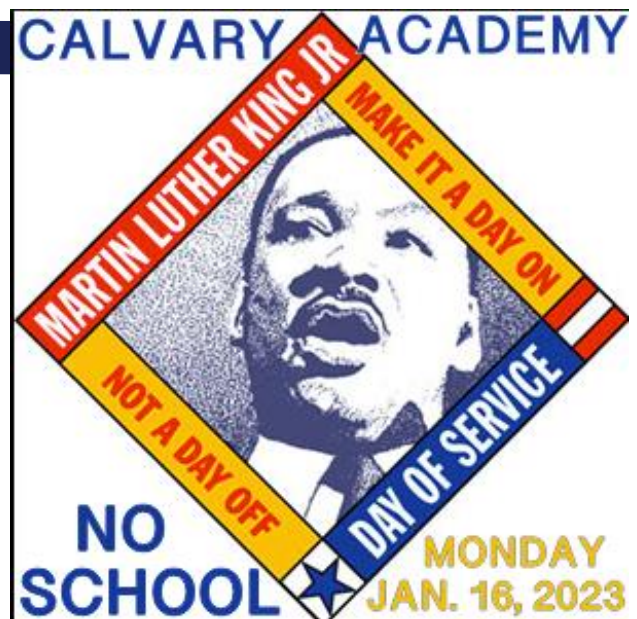

- 3. Who will I become? Some plans may appear suitable but have the potential to pull our hearts from God's will and purpose. If I went around doing whatever I thought I could get by with, I'd be a slave to my whims." 1 Corinthians 6:12 MSG**
