Let's talk about a feeling that might be all too familiar to you: the pain of not being chosen. Perhaps you've been the last one picked in a sports team, overlooked for a job you wanted, or endured the heartache of a breakup. These moments of rejection can deeply affect our emotions and even begin to shape our identity.

However, there is a profound truth that we often overlook in these painful times: in the eyes of God, we are never unseen, never last, and most importantly, never unloved.

Consider the comforting words of Scripture: "I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well." (Psalm 139:14). These words are a reminder that God created you with intention and care. Furthermore, God reassures us, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." (Hebrews 13:5). This promise tells us that we are always chosen by God, even before our very existence in our mother's womb.

Imagine yourself as a hidden gem within an unturned stone. The fact that the gem has not yet been discovered does not diminish its value. Similarly, our worth does not decrease simply because it goes unrecognized by others. We are like undiscovered treasures, each holding unique value and purpose that are recognized and cherished by God, even if the world hasn't realized it yet.

When you feel overlooked by the world, remember that your true identity is not defined by others' opinions or by your circumstances but by God. Each instance of rejection is an opportunity to grow stronger in your faith and to draw closer to the unique purpose God has for your life.

So, the next time you find yourself not picked for a team, passed over for a promotion, or facing any rejection, turn to the word of God. Let it comfort and remind you of your eternal worth.

Remember, you are always chosen in God's story. Stay blessed and see your worth through His eyes.
