Calvary Day Care is licensed by The Department of Children & Family Services for 206 children.

- Infant classroom \$230 weekly
- 3 Toddler classrooms \$220 weekly
- 3 Two-year old rooms \$210 weekly
- 3 Three-year old rooms \$200 weekly
- 3 Four-year old rooms \$200 weekly

Registration Fee is \$50.00

Cot Sheet Fee is \$10.00

Calvary Day Care accepts Illinois Action For Children. You will need to obtain a new application or a change of provider form.

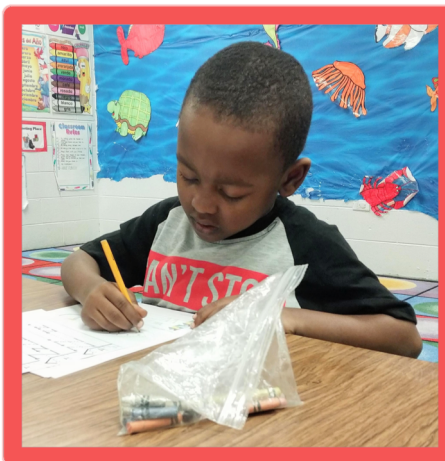

Environment & Development

Bible Time is provided daily which includes worship songs, bible stories and bible verses. Introductory units are used with the infants and toddlers during teaching time. Academic Creative Curriculum is used during two-year old teaching time and ABeka Book Curriculum is used in our 3 & 4-year old classrooms. We provide group phonics and individual academic time to enhance the educational growth of each child. Social skills, number recognition, number concepts, language and listening skills, along with gross and fine motor skills are incorporated into daily instruction.

- Participate in the Illinois Child and Adult Care Food Program



- Separate classrooms with observation windows
- Large fully fenced-in playground with entrance from inside the day care only
- A Gross Motor Room specifically designed for enhancing gross motor skills
- Security cameras located on the outside of the building

Staff

Teachers at Calvary Day Care have exceeded the minimum qualifications to be teacher qualified through DCFS. The teacher assistants are well qualified and help in the day to day classroom structure. Each staff member is a Christian and maintains a regular and contributing involvement in a church. All staff members have completed a background check with the State of Illinois and have to complete 15 hours of continuing education yearly.
