### Prayer Corner: Not Ours

Scripture Reference: John 16:32-33



When you travel and stay in a hotel room, would you buy furniture, paint the walls, replace the carpet and remodel the bathroom? Why not? Because it's not your home.

As Christians, this world is not our permanent home.

Enjoy the journey. Most vacationers take in the scenery, eat good food and make more memories with family. They are relaxed, having fun, and enjoying the moment. It doesn't mean that back home, there aren't serious issues. But they have chosen not to dwell on the struggles but embrace the destination.
